A Year In Review

In 2021, LOSH continued our training on a wide range of worker safety and health issues in both English and Spanish, with an emphasis on hazard identification and control, workers' rights, and leadership development. Initiatives included:

- Work with the Los Angeles Department of Public Health, SoCalCOSH, and a network of worker organizations to train and support workers in forming Public Health Councils in COVID-19 high-risk industries
- Training as part of a statewide initiative to promote awareness of workplace COVID-19 protections and sick leave resources in California
- HAZWOPER and Refresher training for workers who handle chemicals or respond to hazardous spills at their workplaces
- Training with day labor center staff and community health promoters to support education of workers exposed to extreme outdoor heat and wildfire smoke
- Training on effective injury and illness prevention programs for small business owners and school personnel
- Training for workforce development program participants to prepare for entry level environmental and construction jobs
