1. RIGHT TO KNOW

You have a right to know about any hazards in your job and any injury and health information related to those hazards.




2. RIGHT TO PROTECTIONS

Your employer is responsible for providing a safe workplace. This includes controlling hazards, providing training and providing PPE. There are additional hour and industry protections for underage workers.

3. RIGHT TO ACT

You have a right to discuss hazards protections and injuries with your coworkers and bosses. You can refuse unsafe work, and file safety complaints against your boss without fear of retaliation.

4. RIGHT TO COMPENSATION

You have a right to wage replacement and compensation for medical care if you are injured on the job.
