

40-HOUR HAZARDOUS WASTE OPERATIONS & EMERGENCY RESPONSE (HAZWOPER) TRAINING

The UCLA Labor Occupational Safety and Health (LOSH) Program invites you to participate in upcoming in-person 40-Hr HAZWOPER courses.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

General site workers, such as general laborers and equipment operators, engaged in hazardous substance removal or other activities which expose or potentially expose workers to hazardous substances and health hazards should receive 40-Hr training.

COURSE FEATURES

This 40-Hr HAZWOPER course meets initial training requirements for general site workers under 29 CFR 1910.120(e)(3) and 8 CCR 5192 (e)(3).

This five-day course will feature live instruction, demonstrations, videos, and activities centered around topics relevant to general site workers.

Upon completion of the course, participants will receive a 40-Hr HAZWOPER certificate. Participants are also eligible to receive 40.0 REHS contact hours.

One-hour lunch breaks and short breaks are given throughout each day.
